## Gleneagles Pie Baking Contest

What is it?
The Pie Baking Contest is one of the many attractions at the Harvest Festival. It encourages bakers young and old to donate their favourite pie to the Harvest Festival's fundraising initiative. It is a fun opportunity for
 students/parents to submit their best family recipe to be judged by a panel of student/parent/teacher judges in one of three possible categories: "Apple", "Pumpkin" and "WOW!" category (an "anything goes" category). Pie pieces that are not used in the judging are sold at the Gleneagles kitchen during the Harvest Festival.

## Rules:

- All pies must NOT be accompanied by a garnish (e.g. whipped cream/ice cream) unless specifically listed in the pie recipe and thus constitute an essential ingredient to the pie's form and flavour. (e.g. chocolate mousse pie or whipped Key Lime Pie).
- Pies must arrive pre-cut into 8 pieces in advance of the start of the Harvest Festival. See location below.

Ludging: Student judges will be overseen by a parent/teacher judge and will be required to evaluate one pie category only, (e.g pumpkin pie judges only evaluate the pumpkin pies, etc.). Parent/teacher judges will be responsible for assisting the student judges, collecting and tallying the marks, and reporting the scores to the pie contest organizer. Judges will be required to evaluate the pies on the basis of their appearance and taste. Three winners (one from each category) will be announced later that evening.

Materials and Location: No materials are needed! Simply bring your delicious, pre-cut pie to the gym stage by $4: 45 \mathrm{pm}$. Please ensure that the baker's name is clearly labelled on the underside of your pie plate. You can retrieve your plate from the Gleneagles Kitchen after the remaining pie pieces have been sold.
